Dear Parents,

In preparation for a healthy school year, the PRISMS health office would like to provide the following helpful and important information. Nurse office's purpose is to support a safe and healthy school environment. School nurses need your assistance as we work together toward this common goal. PRISMS use Magnus Health as a student medical record system. Parents can submit and access health information for your student. Parents can help us by completing all medical consent forms, annual physical exam form on the Magnus Health, and email me a copy of your child's medical insurance card. All students are required to have health insurance. PRISMS offers a student health plan for International students. Please contact accounting department for detail.

Please review the information:

- Immunizations must be up to date according to the New Jersey State Department of Education guidelines for school entry and attendance.
- All medications and medical procedures at school must have completed paper work. I will send out login information to new parents on the month of May. Please see Magnus Health website at <https://secure.magnushealthportal.com> or contact school nurse for detail.
- State screening mandates are performed for vision, hearing, and Scoliosis. If a health conditions are detected during the screening, I will send home a referral for your child to have further examination.
- Current health information is crucial for proper care. Please notify your school nurse of all health related issues. This can be done via the Parent Portal: <https://secure.magnushealthportal.com> or by visiting school nurse.

Also, by reviewing a PRISMS Health Services Policy on Magnus Health for your children when they are not feeling well.

- Day student:
 - Fever of 100° or more for the duration of the fever plus an additional 24 hours after cessation without fever-reducing medication
 - Vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours after cessation
 - Generalized rash
 - Red, draining eye
 - Untreated live lice
- A boarder student's parents will be notified upon his/her admission to the infirmary. During his/her stay they will be contacted daily and as needed.
